



IVY BRACELET

Design and pattern by Sandra Lindahl

Difficulty: Easy-Intermediate



This pattern is for personal use only.

Finished jewellery may be sold in limited quantity but not for mass production.
I would be happy if you credited me as the designer.

Materials for a 9 unit bracelet

Materials	Amount
6 mm Fire Polished beads	10 pcs
4 mm Fire Polished beads	36 pcs (\approx 2g)
4x3 mm Crystal Rondelles	36 pcs (\approx 3g)
11/0 seed beads	\approx 2-3g
Fireline 6lb	\approx 2.5 arm spans
Size 12 needle	
Clasp of your choice and jump rings	

Bracelet length

Note that the length of the bracelet will differ depending on the brand of seed beads.

Length without clasp:

9 units with Toho will measure approximately 17 cm/6.7"

10 units with Toho will measure approximately 18.8 cm/7.4"

9 units with Miyuki will measure approximately 15.7 cm/6.18"

10 units with Miyuki will measure approximately 17.3 cm/6.8"

Colour examples



6 mm Fire Polished: Chalk Red Luster

4 mm Fire Polished: Pastel Cream

4x3 mm Rondelle: Crystal Capri Gold

11/0 Miyuki: Duracoat Galvanized Champagne



6 mm Fire Polished: Etched Crystal Magic Wine

4 mm Fire Polished: Metallic Lime, Halo Madder Rose

4x3 mm Rondelle: Dark green

11/0 Toho: Metallic Iris Brown


Abbreviations and explanations


FP6	= Fire Polish 6 mm
FP4	= Fire Polish 4mm
Rondelle	= 4x3 mm Crystal Rondelle
11/0	= 11/0 seed bead


In the diagrams

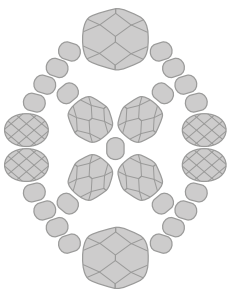
● = Black dot is where your step starts

 = 11/0

 = Rondelle

 = FP4

 = FP6



Do not pass through grey beads



Thread your needle

Thread your needle with a length you are comfortable with.

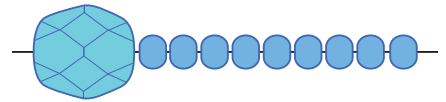
You will need approximately 2.5 arm spans in total.

I recommend using a colour that will not show much with your beads.

Step 1

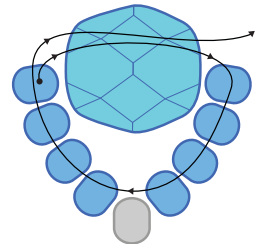
Pick up 1 FP6 and 9 11/0.

Bring the beads down your thread leaving a long enough end for you to comfortably tie off later.



Step 2

Pass through the FP6 and 4 11/0, skip 1 11/0, pass through the next 4 11/0 and FP6.



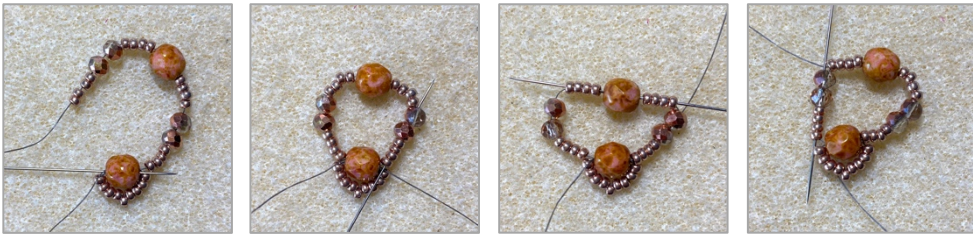
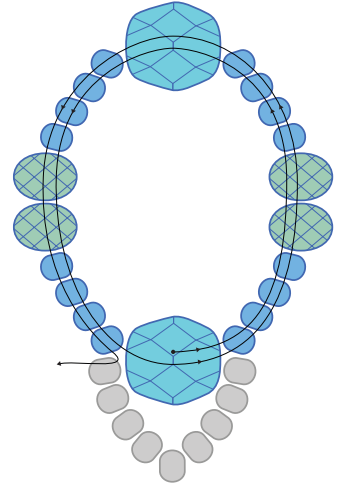
Step 1-2 completed:



Step 3

Pick up 4 11/0, 2 Rondelles, 4 11/0, 1 FP6, 4 11/0, 2 Rondelles and 4 11/0.

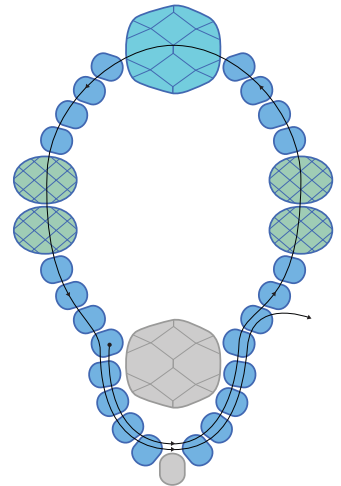
Pass through the FP6 from step 2 and pass through all the beads you just added. You should be exiting from the last 11/0 added.



Step 4

Pass through 4 11/0 from step 1, skip 1 11/0, pass through 4 11/0.

Pass through all your added beads from step 3 one more time, pass through 4 11/0 from step 1, skip 1 11/0, pass through 6 11/0.

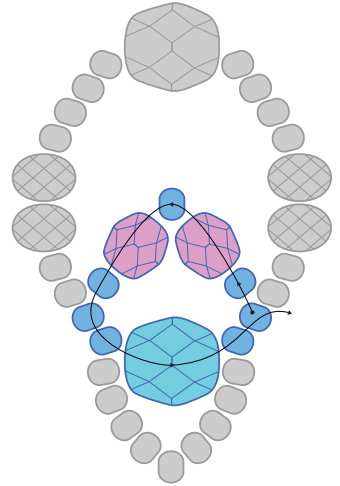


Step 5

Pick up 1 11/0, 1 FP4, 1 11/0, 1 FP4, 1 11/0.

Pass through the 2 11/0 on the other side of the FP6, pass through the FP6 and 2 11/0.

You will now be coming out of the same 11/0 as you started this step in.



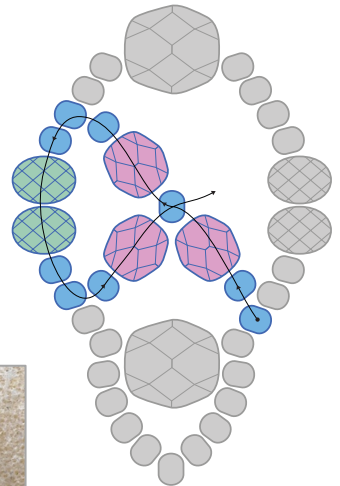
Step 6

Pass through the 11/0, FP4 and 11/0 that you just added.

Pick up 1 FP4 and 1 11/0.

Pass through 2 11/0, 2 Rondelles and 2 11/0 in a direction towards the last FP4 added in step 5.

Pass through the 11/0, FP4 and 11/0 from step 5.

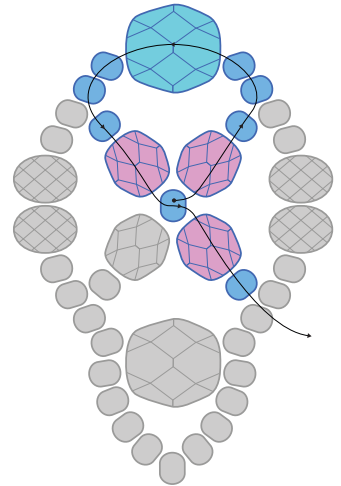


Step 7

Pick up 1 FP4 and 1 11/0.

Pass through 2 11/0, 1 FP6 and 2 11/0 at the top of your work towards the FP4 added in step 6.

Now diagonally pass through the 11/0 and FP4 from step 6 and through the 11/0, FP4 and 11/0 from step 5.



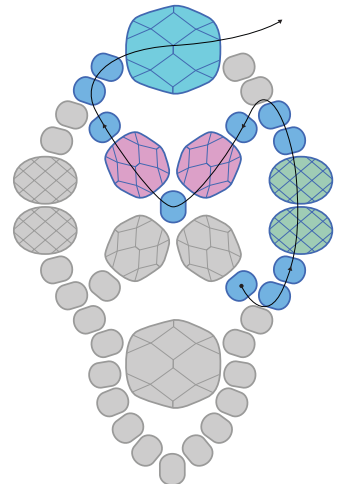
Step 8

Pass through 2 11/0, 2 Rondelles and 2 11/0 towards the FP4 added in step 7.

Pass through 1 11/0, 1 FP4 and 1 11/0. You should now be exiting from the middle 11/0.

Pass through the FP4 and 11/0 from step 6.

Pass through 2 11/0 and 1 FP6.



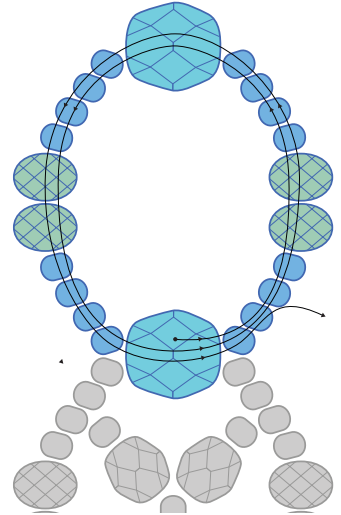
Step 9

Pick up 4 11/0, 2 Rondelles, 4 11/0, 1 FP6, 4 11/0, 2 Rondelles and 4 11/0.

Pass through the FP6 you are coming out of and through all the beads you just added,

Pass through 1 FP6.

Pass through the first 2 11/0 from this step.



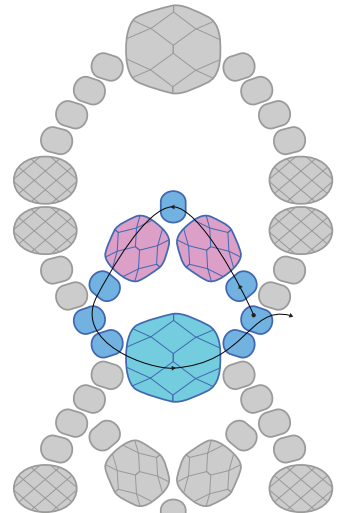
Step 10

Same as step 5.

Pick up 1 11/0, 1 FP4, 1 11/0, 1 FP4, 1 11/0.

Pass through the 2 11/0 on the other side of the FP6, pass through the FP6 and 2 11/0.

You will now be coming out of the same 11/0 as you started this step in.



Step 11

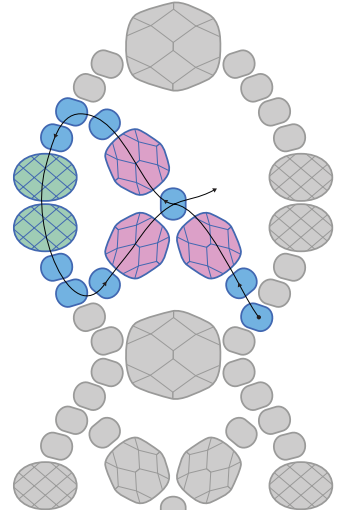
Same as step 6.

Pass through the 11/0, FP4 and 11/0 that you just added.

Pick up 1 FP4 and 1 11/0.

Pass through 2 11/0, 2 Rondelles and 2 11/0 on the other side of the big loop in a direction towards the last FP4 added in step 10.

Pass through the 11/0, FP4 and 11/0 from step 10.



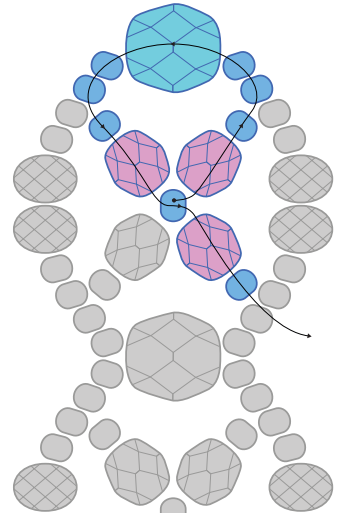
Step 12

Same as step 7.

Pick up 1 FP4 and 1 11/0.

Pass through 2 11/0, 1 FP6 and 2 11/0 at the top of your work towards the FP4 that you added in step 11.

Now diagonally pass through the 11/0 and FP4 from step 11 and the FP4 and 11/0 from step 10.

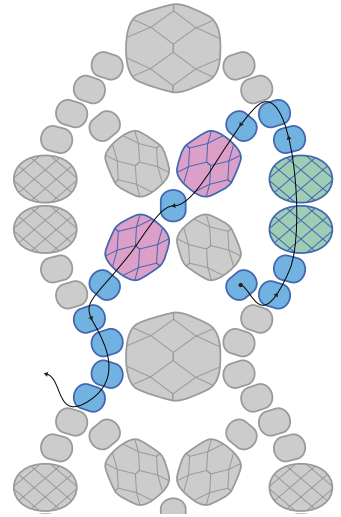


Step 13

Pass through 2 11/0, 2 Rondelles and 2 11/0 towards the last FP4 added in step 12.

Now diagonally pass through the 11/0 and FP4 from step 12 and the 11/0, FP4 and 11/0 from step 10.

Pass through the 4 11/0 closest to the FP6.



Step 14

Pick up 4 11/0.

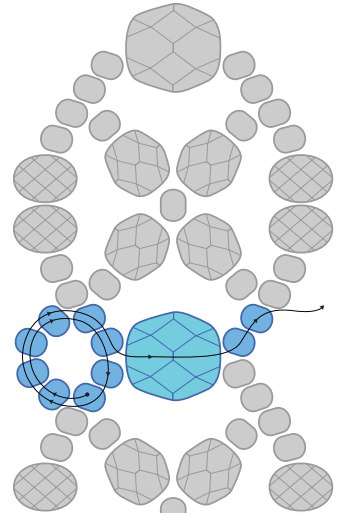
Pass through the same 4 11/0 that you passed through in step 12.

Pass through the 4 11/0 just added.

Pass through 2 11/0 and 1 FP6.

Pass through 2 11/0 in the direction towards the last rondelles you added.

Tip: If the loop that we just added looks a bit uneven you can use your needle to nudge the beads into place.



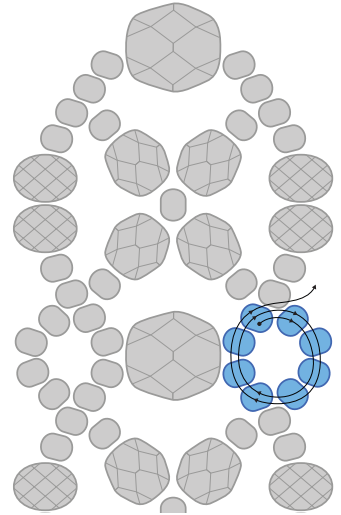
Step 15

Pick up 4 11/0.

As in the previous step, pass through 4 11/0 to make a loop and come back out of the 11/0 you started this step in.

Pass through the four beads you just added and through the same 4 11/0 that you just passed through.

You will now be coming out of the same 11/0 that you started this step in.

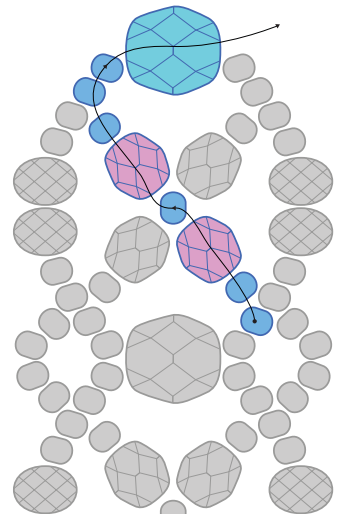


Step 16

Pass through the 11/0, FP4 and 11/0 from step 10.

Pass through the FP4 and 11/0 from step 11.

Pass through 2 11/0 and 1 FP6.



Step 16 completed:



Step 17

Repeat steps 9-16 until you have the length that you want for your bracelet. The final steps will add another 3-4 mm to the length of the bracelet, clasp not included.

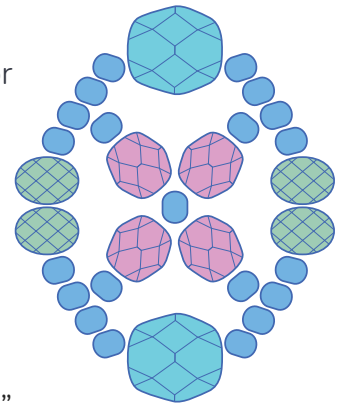
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10 units with Toho will measure approximately 18.8 cm/7.4"

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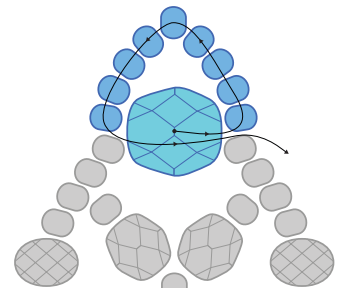
10 units with Miyuki will measure approximately 17.3 cm/6.8"



1 unit

Step 18

Pick up 9 11/0 and pass through the FP6.



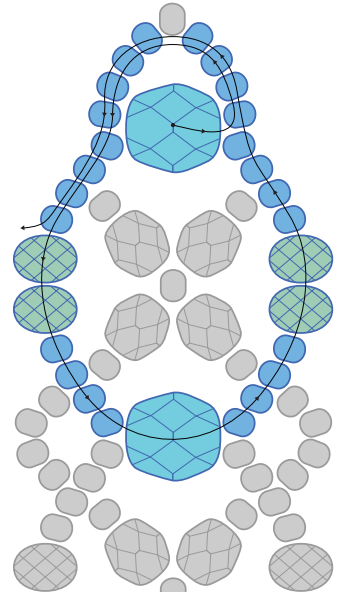
Step 19

Pass through 4 11/0, skip 1 11/0, pass through 8 11/0.

Pass through 2 Rondelles, 4 11/0, 1 FP6.

Pass through 4 11/0, 2 Rondelles, 8 11/0.

Skip 1 11/0 and pass through 8 11/0.



Final step

Tie off your ends and attach your jump rings and clasp.
